Citizen in Power hosted the meeting where partners made decisions on the project and discussed about youth participation in Europe.

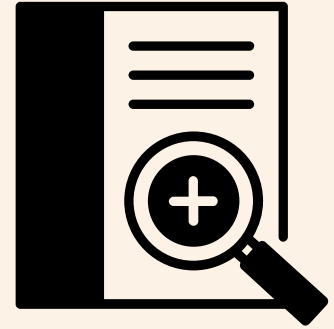

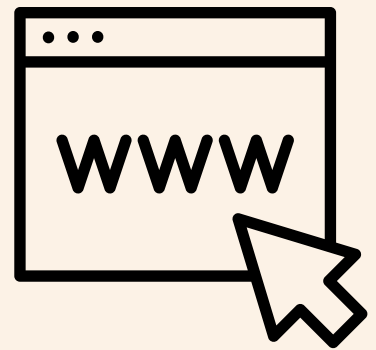
## Next deliveries
